Additionally, Pacifica Mariners Baseball is still selling \$15 game ticket vouchers to future Angels games.

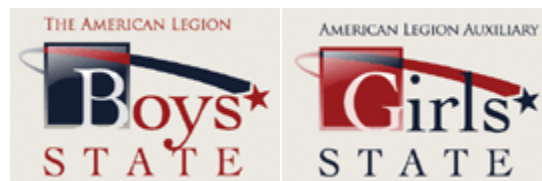
